Previous meeting Follow-up:

- Detailed analysis of the result has been done. The deviation in result between odd and even semester was attributed to the dip in result in first semester (entry of the first year students) and III semester (entry into the core subject). In the VIII semester the result tends to be high as there are only 2 or 3 subjects. This trend has been observed across all colleges.
- In accordance to the suggestions given in the previous Governing body meeting that the funds received for various heads like MODROB, FDP, STTP, Seminar, Workshops, Conferences, Research Proposals and Student Projects etc. would be indicated in lakes instead of numbers.
- Got approval for Artificial Intelligence & Data science and Artificial Intelligence & Machine Learning with an intake of 60 candidates each from 2021 recognized by AICTE and Anna University.

Minutes (17.12.2021)

- 1. Resolved to approve the budget submitted for the Academic year 2021–2022. The details are enclosed in **Annexure I.**
- 2. A briefing on the courses and the details of admitted students for the academic year 2021-2022 was presented by the Principal. The details are enclosed in **Annexure II.**
- 3. Dr. S. Matilda, Vice Principal & Dean Academics presented the details of the BOS meeting held in April/May 2021 and the third Academic Council meeting held on May 8th, 2021.
- 4. The content of the syllabus and choice of text books were appreciated.
- 5. Resolved to include latest field oriented techniques / technologies /topics and recommended to solve ambiguity in laboratory experiments.
- 6. Resolved to include standard books by Indian authors with recent editions as text and reference books.
- 7. Resolved to maintain flow for shuffling of courses between semesters, Change in name of courses and new open elective courses to cater the latest technologies. Also outdated Professional elective courses can be discarded.
- 8. Resolved to offer Science Fiction as an open elective by Department of English.
- 9. Resolved to enhance the syllabus by introducing lifelong learning skills /human values/Gender equity and ethics based courses in the curriculum.

- 11. Faculty members were appreciated for their contribution as a Primary evaluator for Toycathon 2021.
- 12. The best student project of IETE award entitled IOT Based Smart Food Grain Wastage Monitoring and Controlling Systems for Warehouse were enlightened.

- 13. Resolved to encourage the third year students to do innovative projects in core areas which would eventually lead to publications and patents.
- 14. Results of Nov/Dec 2020 and Apr/May 2021 end semester examination was placed before the Governing body members. A comparison with the previous semesters was also done.
- 15. Resolved to do an in-depth analysis for the wide deviation in result between odd and even semester to identify the root cause of the problem, such as nature of the subject, question paper etc.
- 16. New Facilities and Major Equipment's procured by the institution were explained.
- 17. Discussed about the feedbacks collected from all levels of stakeholders (Students, Faculty and Alumni & Employers). Resolved to take action as given in the proceeding.
- 18. Highlights of placement and the internship offers received by the students were placed before the members. They appreciated the training methodology adopted.
